



As a professional artist/illustrator, Sherry Lane has been capturing the essence of people in cartoon and caricature for many years. She has drawn celebrities at Sardi's, traveled throughout the country for Time Magazine, British Airways and around the world twice for Pan Am World Airways. She has lectured at colleges and universities across the USA and appeared on radio and television shows, including "Live at Five" NBC News, and "Good Day New York" Fox news. She was featured in "New York Nick" on The Style Channel, invited to do a small part on the Soprano's and her caricatures have been seen on Comedy Central. Many major corporations collect her work.

Sherry does portraits in acrylic, oil, watercolor and clay. She has exhibited her work at the Westbeth Gallery and at the Salmagundi Club, the oldest artist's club in America. She has been an artist member of the Salmagundi Club since 1987. She is also a member of the National Caricaturists Network and founder of the New York Chapter.

Sherry's caricatures were published in Star Magazine, her sculpture can be found in the Encyclopedia of Living Artist in America and she is listed in Contemporary Graphic Artists. As a member of the Graphic Artists Guild, her caricatures can be seen in the Graphic Artists Guild Directory of Illustration #10 and #14.

Sherry is a member of the Upper Catskill Arts Council and is an active teaching artist in the Collaborative Arts in Education Program.

She has served on the Westbeth Artists Residents Council as Chairperson of the Visual Arts committee and as Treasurer.
