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ARTIST STATEMENT:

My education and teaching have been based in photography and alternative processes. The politics of representation became increasingly important to me and, with the advent and growth of technologies, I have been creating portfolios of imagery based on and growing out of the body and a relationship to community.

In this project fingerprints reference the body, utilizing a personal mark as well as lend a universal reading. The layers of process map a path, exploring identity and its relationship to community. This portfolio allows me to meditate on my identity in the context of the larger world [and other concerns].

My work has been about the body. My concern is about community. I am investigating the pride of my and our identities. I take on the challenge to explore how we can have these identities and co-exist in a community.

As a gay man, I work with images from many sources: 'beefcake images' and male nudes that explore a queer sensibility. Some of the images are vintage; others are from catalogues, newspaper circulars, cartoons, soap, food and other packaging. Sometimes they are just fingerprints, patterns and colors. Often there is a multiplicity of meanings.

These prints are my own montages created by layering and adjusting the opacity of the different elements; often parts of an image morph into another. Masking is utilized to both reveal and hide processes contributing to my vision.
